The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is a process of formation, education, and initiation for those who desire to come into full communion with our faith community. It is for those who:

- ◆ have never been baptized, or
- ◆ have been baptized in a non-Catholic denomination and would like to come into full communion with the Church, or
- ◆ were baptized Catholic but have never received the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

Classes for both Sacred Heart and Holy Rosary parishes are held in Sacred Heart's Parish Center. Our first class meets on Wednesday, September 4<sup>th</sup>, from 7 to 9 PM in the Bornemann room. Classes will continue to meet every Wednesday until Pentecost.
