## FOURTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR



**B**earing a yoke would not seem to be an enjoyable experience. But Jesus gives us this image in today's gospel reading and nearly subverts it. The yoke of Jesus, the One who is meek and humble of heart, is itself easy; the burden is light. This seems to be a different image than "take up your cross and follow Me." In today's gospel, we learn that when we are true disciples of Christ, we

conform to the person Himself. So conformed, we find any burden not to be a burden at all.

**T**o live the paschal mystery with Christ is to live with the knowledge that we are His. He has already won the victory. Secure in this relationship with Him, we need only act as He would in the world, as another Christ to serve the needs of those around us. Any setback or death we experience will find new life due to the same Christ we serve. This is good news, and a spiritually rewarding way to live the paschal mystery.

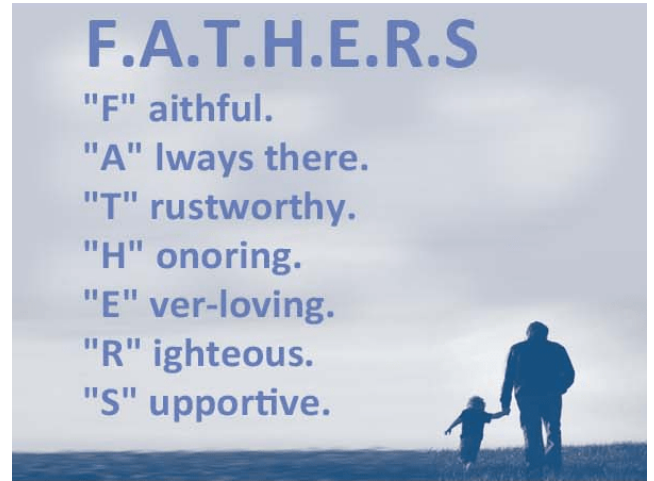

### SHRINE VOTIVE OFFERINGS


