CHRIST THE KING

It is a bold thing to identify with Christ. From the Sermon on the Mount with the Beatitudes, to this concluding teaching of Jesus on judgment, being a follower of Christ is not for the faint of heart. Self-sacrifice, love of the other, and service are central to the identity of a Christian. How mortally dangerous it is, then, to call oneself Christian, to claim

the role of disciple, without performing the actions required by one. It would be better not to claim the title at all.

Essential Matthean themes are expressed in this story: doing versus merely saying, is one. Doing the will of God—caring for the poor and for the stranger—is not merely about performing kind acts but is the basis of salvation, for Christian and non-Christian alike. As we live the paschal mystery, let us keep before us the awesome call and responsibility to express our faith in action, not merely words.
